
MESSAGE FROM OUR HIGH PRIEST & PROPHET

Fraternal greetings to all Moslem Shriners.

Shriners International has started sending out dues notices for 2022 by email and United States mail. There have been questions emailed and telephoned to the Shrine office relating to the 2022 dues. Hopefully the information below can answer some of your questions.

Dues Information

Members will less than 35 years: \$102.50

Members with 35 years: \$52.50

50 years Total Life: \$35.00

Should you wish to purchase Lifetime Memberships, please see below:

Lifetime Memberships:

Members younger than 65 years of age: 20 times current dues (Temple dues)

Temple dues: $$67.50 \times 20 = $1,350.00$

Per Capita (Shriners International): \$30.00 x 30 = \$900.00

Hospital Assessment: \$5.00 x 30 = \$150.00

Total: \$2,400.00

Members 65 years and older of age: 10 times current dues (Temple dues)

Temple dues: $$67.00 \times 10 = 675.00

Per Capita (Shriners International): \$30.00 x 30 = \$900.00

Hospital Assessment: \$5.00 x 30 = \$150.00

Total: \$1,725.00

If you wish' you can pay only one or two of the three of the Lifetime Membership categories of dues, which reduces what your dues will be in the future.

LM = Temple Dues Portion (Moslem Shriners)

PCLM = Per Capita Portion (Shriners International)

PCM = Hospital Assessment Portion (Shriners Hospitals for Children)

If you take a Lifetime Membership portion for the temple, those funds are invested and only the interest can go the General Fund.
