A Brief History of American Legion, George Washington Post 88

American Legion, George Washington Post 88, was founded in 1922 by a group of Free Masons (Permanent Charter issues Nov 8, 1922, record number 6748). The Post has maintained a Masonic membership since its early inception and for the last several years has maintained a close relationship with Moslem Shrine.

For decades the Post held their meetings at the Masonic Temple in Detroit. In the 1990's the Post met at the home of Adjutant Frank O'Boyle. When his health began to decline, he moved to the Alma Masonic Home. He wanted to move the post to that location; however the remaining members wished to keep the post in the Metropolitan Detroit area.

Under the leadership of Commander Wilbur Shaffmaster, with the assistance of First Vice Commander Raymond Anderson and Adjutant Paul Johnston, our Post began a revitalization program in 2008. We began with 12 members in 2008 and we now have 63 members and growing.

Our membership is diverse and consists of WWII, Korean, Vietnam, Panama, Persian Gulf, Iraq/Afghanistan, and War on Terror veterans. We have Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine and Coast Guard members. Our Masonic affiliations include Blue Lodge, Grand Lodge, Scottish Rite, Royal Arch, Shiners, Royal Order of Scotland and Knights Templar.

Under Commander Eugene Pisha, we adopted the following Mission Statement in 2013:

"Our mission is to promote the ideals stated in the preamble to the Constitution of the American Legion and the Masonic tenets of Brotherly Love, Relief, and Truth to Michigan veterans through active participation in organizations, thoughtful and relevant education, charitable programs, and exemplary behaviors in all endeavors."

A few of the Post activities includes support for DeMolay lads to attend Boys State, we have bought Christmas Gifts for deployed service members children, we were instrumental in organizing WWII veterans from all across the state to attend a three day trip to New Orleans to visit the WWII National Museum and we annually give to the Fisher House in Michigan and numerous other veteran and first responder organizations.

For 8 years we have met at the Shrine Temple in Southfield. Currently the George Washinton Post 88, meets at the Berkley Post on 12 Mile Rd. We meet only four times a year and our next meeting is on April 5, 2022 at 7PM. We are looking forward to the acquisition of our new Shrine Temple
