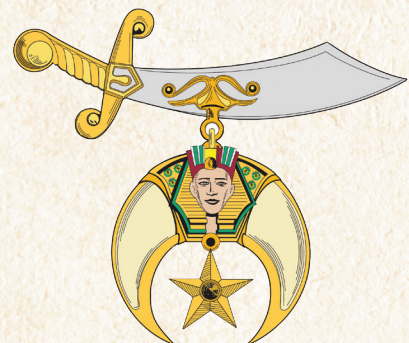

MESSAGE FROM OUR RECORDER

As Moslem Shriners has initiated several new Nobles of the Mystic Realm, I thought I would explain some the words used by Shriners.

Aide

A noble appointed by a Potentate or Imperial Potentate to assist him with duties during his term.

Ambassador

A noble appointed by a Potentate to represent him and the temple at club, unit meetings, functions and Masonic lodges.

Black Camel

Term used to refer to the death of a member of the Shriners fraternity.

Bylaws

The rules and regulations governing Shriners International and each temple.

Cabiri

A social organization composed of Past Potentates.

Candidate

A Mason who has petitioned for membership in the Shriners fraternity.

Ceremonial

The Shriner initiation ceremony.

Editorial Without Words

The image of a Shriner carrying a little girl and her crutches. This image originated from a photograph and has been reflected in statues, graphics and other media as a symbol of the Shriners fraternity and Shriners Hospitals for Children. It is currently an important part of the visual identity of Shriners Hospital for Children.

Elected Divan

The collective name of the officers of the Shriners temple: the Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest and Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer and Recorder.

Fez

The official headgear worn by members of the Shriners fraternity. It derives its name from the city where it was first manufactured – Fez, Morocco.

Imperial Council

The body of representatives from each of the 191 temples, which determines the direction of the fraternity.

Imperial Divan

Twelve officers elected by the Imperial Council to lead the Shrine Fraternity.

Imperial Sir

The title preceding the name of a Shriner who is serving or has served on the Imperial Divan.

Imperial Council Session

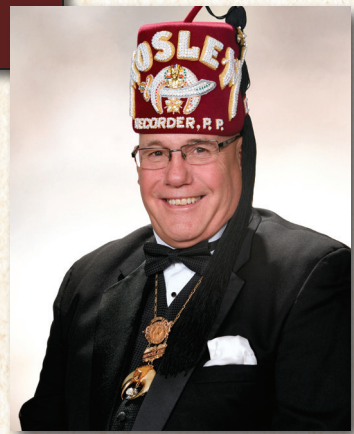
The Shriners' annual convention, generally held during the first week of July. The business of the fraternity and Shriners Hospitals for Children are conducted at that time. Also, there are parades, unit competitions and social events during the session.

Illustrious Sir

The title preceding the name of a Shriner who is serving, or has served, as Potentate of his temple.

Lady

The title preceding the name of the wife of any Shriner. The wife of a Potentate or the Imperial Potentate is referred to as the First Lady.

In 2022, Shriners Erie Hospital achieved the following excellent results:

- 208 Surgical cases with our regional partners at the cost of only \$12,091.00 to Shriners
- 23,091 Rehab procedures
- 8,408 Clinical procedures
- Patient charges \$7,175,515
- Cash received \$1,037,148
- Patient revenue \$1,058,705
- Donations \$2,850,000
- Total Draw on Endowment of \$584,000. Representing the lowest in the System, accounting for less than 5 percent of the total draw from the Shriners Children's System.

What is the "Pull-Tab Collection Program"?

Pull-tabs, or pop tabs, from beverage cans can be saved and donated to the Moslem Shriners. The tabs are sold to a recycling company and the money collected is used to help Shrine Kids.
