

## MESSAGE FROM OUR POTENTATE

Nobles,

We are going to keep the communication up throughout the year with 4 mailed Moslemite Magazines and monthly smaller electronic versions. Please check [detroitshriners.com](http://detroitshriners.com) for regular updates on what's going on with your Temple.

On Monday, January 18th, we held our Stated Meeting virtually on Zoom. This is by far not the preferred way to meet but, for now it's all we have. I'd like to thank all those that attended on their phone or computer. Trying to conduct business in the Zoom format is very challenging. Delays in responses, difficulty in displaying information, difficulty in sharing feedback from participants are only a few of the hurdles we face.

I'd like to offer a few suggestions, should we meet virtually again. First, everyone must register in advance for the meeting. This is how we "tile" the meeting and confirm all in attendance are Nobles in good standing. Second, don't wait until the last minute to Log In. I hope we can meet in person at the Shrine Center but, we are preparing to meet via Zoom if a physical meeting isn't possible. We will be voting on both the selling of our current building and purchasing another. We are in final negotiations selling and have submitted a purchase agreement for the smaller Elks building. Please register then, log on for Zoom early. Subjects to discuss at the Special meeting are 2021 Budget recap, Sale of the Southfield Bldg, Purchase of the Waterford Bldg and the Building Fund. These will be the only items we are allowed to discuss.

Lastly, tickets and flyers for the rescheduled Sportsman's Raffle are now available at the Shrine office. The Sportsman's Raffle has been rescheduled for Saturday, June 5th at the Suburban Collection Showplace in Novi after a 4-month delay due to Covid. It's imperative that we all do our part to sell tickets and make the event successful. We count on the cash flow this event generates each year and we have already been delayed 4 months. ## MESSAGE FROM OUR RECORDER

FROM THE DESK OF THE RECORDER ROBERT PATE, PP



Greetings to my fellow Nobles, hope this article finds you and yours safe and well.

What I'm going to discuss is Moslem Shriners' dues and how they are broke down. The dues schedule can be confusing, but I will attempt to clear the dues structure up. My examples will be based on those paying the full amount. Nobles who have 35 or 50 years as paying members will have a lower payment.

Presently a Noble of Moslem Shriners pays \$89.00. Of the \$89.00, \$5.00 goes to Shriners Hospitals for Children; \$30.00 goes to Shriners International and \$54.00 goes to operate the Shrine Center. As you can see there are three (3) parts to your dues. Please remember that the Nobility has approved an increase to the 2022 Temple dues from \$54.00 to \$67.50, bringing the new Moslem Shriners' dues to \$102.50 (including Hospital and Per Capita assessments).

I will attempt to explain how a Noble can reduce part or all of their yearly dues payment.

**Shriners Hospitals for Children Assessment** - The By-Laws of Shriners International, Section 332.3 (a) states that the annual levy for the Hospitals will be \$5.00, except for associate members, associate members pay the \$5.00 assessment to their home Temple.

Now if you wish to make a permanent contributing payment or become a Permanent Contributing Member (PCM), you may purchase a \$150.00 Permanent Contributing Membership in the Hospitals, receive a certificate from the Recorder of the Temple and be exempt from any further hospital levy. This would lower you annual dues by \$5.00 per year. This complies with Shriners International By-Laws Section 332.4 (a).

**Per Capita Tax** – The By-Laws of Shriners International, Section 211.5, Per Capita Tax, states that each Temple shall pay an annual per capita tax to Shriners International of \$30.00 for each member of the Temple as of the first day of January of each year.

A Noble may purchase a Life Per Capita Membership (Section 211.5 (g)) by paying to his temple recorder a sum equal to 30 times the current per capita tax and, thereafter, he is exempt from the annual per capita tax. With the current per capita tax of \$30.00 times 30, the cost for a Life Per Capita Membership is \$900.00.

**Life Membership** - The By-Laws of Shriners International, Section 332.6 (3)(i) when a member who is under 65 years of age pays the temple, in one lump sum, not less than 20 times the temple's current annual dues. Moslem Shriners' present dues are \$67.50. Take the \$67.50 times 20 which comes to \$1,350.00.

The By-Laws of Shriners International, Section 332.6 (3)(ii), when a member who is 65 years of age or older pays the temple, in one lump sum, not less than 10 times the temple's current annual dues. Moslem Shriners' present dues are \$67.50. Take the \$67.50 times 10 comes to \$675.00.

**Board of Directors Responsibility** – All money received from life memberships shall be placed in a perpetual fund. Only the income from the fund may be withdrawn and used for the operating expenses of the temple.

You can lower or eliminate all or part of your dues by pre-paying any or all of the three divisions of Moslem Shriners' dues. Should you have any questions relating to your dues, please feel free to contact me at the Shrine Center (248-569-2900 Ext 4).

If you are a Noble who has 35 years or more as a paying member in 2022 you pay \$17.50 temple dues, \$5.00 Hospital Assessment and \$30.00 Per Capita tax which comes to \$52.50.

Those members who have 50 years or more as a paying member in 2022, you will pay no temple dues, \$5.00 Hospital Assessment and \$30.00 Per Capita tax which comes to \$35.00.

I hope I have been able to clear up Moslem Shriners' dues structure.




