

Who is Ladies' Oriental Shrine of North America, Inc?

The Ladies' Oriental Shrine of North America (LOSNA) was founded in Wheeling, West Virginia in 1903. As the organization grew, the need for a body of representatives was formed in 1914 and became known as the Grand Council. Za-hir-u-din Court No. 7 of LOSNA was instituted in Detroit, Michigan in 1920. The top official of the Grand Council is known as the Grand High Priestess and the Executive Officer in the local Court is known as the High Priestess. When the Shriners founded the Shrine Hospitals for Children and the first hospital was built in 1922, the Ladies committed to supporting the Shrine's official philanthropy. The LOSNA contributes well over a half million dollars yearly to the Shrine Hospitals. Within our Court, Ladies may choose to be active in a variety of special interest Units. Our Ladies are always ready to display their pageantry and glamour in order to show the public how much they enjoy their activities. We are a century of sisterhood. A Detroit ladies tradition.

Within the past few years, LOSNA has expanded our membership requirements to be more inclusive to those without a Masonic connection. All Ladies, at least 18 years of age, with an interest in our mission and philanthropy are encouraged to join and become part of our legacy. Do you want to make a difference in the life of a child and their family? Do you want to be part of something bigger than yourself? Do you want to have fun while helping others? Then Ladies, we are just what you are looking for!
