

Did you have an opportunity to attend the Michigan State Fair and Detroit Shrine Circus during the 2021 Labor Day weekend? What an amazing comeback weekend after 2020 being a virtual only event. There were 287,000 people in attendance, which was a 62% increase in attendance from 2019. The Michigan State Fair gave back \$867,000 to local charities, even Shriners Children's was the recipient of \$10,000! They also gave away 67, \$1,000 scholarships.

Our Shriners and their families and friends Rock! Moslem Shriners not only had to have volunteers for the Shrine Circus, but we also provided volunteers for the State Fair. **We are doing it all over again this Labor Day weekend!** We need volunteers for fire watch, wrist band checking, Fair office, crowd control, entrance gate ambassadors, you name it, we volunteer for it. New this year, Moslem will be running the Taft Road parking lot all weekend. 



Besides legislation, meetings, meeting and catching up with people, etc. we get inspiring messages from many.

This year, inspiring messages from now Past Imperial Potentate Bill Bailey, new Imperial Potentate Kenny Craven, Imperial Chaplain Jerry Oliver, Imperial Chairman of the Board Jerry Gantt and representatives from Masonic Grand Masters, Scottish Rite, York Rite leaders and more.

Each presentation is different but, the messages presented by everyone contain the importance of living our Masonic Values. Many of these messages bring forth a deeper feeling or emotion within the listener.

Imperial Potentate Kenny has a passion for sports. He is very involved with the Imperial Sports Committee and the major hospital fundraisers. It's no surprise that both new patient representatives are athletes. Patient representatives Katherine and Parker both had very serious leg injuries in accidents and were introduced to us via video about each other then, in person. Thanks to Shriners Children's Hospitals, both patient representatives are "Back in the Game".

Imperial Sir Kenny stated that we must focus on membership, fundraising and our mission. He stressed that we must be unstoppable. "A winning effort begins with preparation" and "it's not about the X's and O's, it's about the people".

In total, over \$6,500,000 in donations to Shriners Childrens were presented on stage by various Shrine centers and ladies' groups. Potentate Tim Lancaster and a contingent from Moslem presented \$50,000 to the First Lady J.J. Cravens' hospital project. No wonder 5 Shriners hospitals are ranked in the top 50 in the U.S. for children's orthopedics.

Each year, when you leave an Imperial Session, you have an overall renewal of passion, love and appreciation for our fraternity and philanthropy.

We're excited to announce the new digital membership card. Effective August 2022, Nobles who pay their 2023 dues will have immediate access to their newly designed digital Membership card.

Nobles can access and present their digital membership card, which features the status of their dues two ways:

My FezCard Viewer available for download on Apple App Store or Google Play App Store.

Member Center Locate on the new SI.org Website.

For 2023, the two primary methods to determine if a member is current in their dues will include asking the Noble to present their new digital membership card on a mobile device or for the temple, club, or unit to scan the QR code on the Nobles existing hard card.

Scanning the QR code on the membership card, either the existing hard card or the new digital card, provides several benefits to the temple including in the area of operations and as a member engagement tool:

Decreases temple expenses by not having to pay for stickers and buck slip insert

Simplifies operation, no need to replace stickers on an annual basis

Digital card/scanning QR quickly determines the status of dues payment

Member Engagement:

Awarding credit for attendance at events and activities, which is especially handy for temples that award points and prizes for participation

Participating in contests and giveaways

Expressing an interest in joining a club or unit

Registering for an event or volunteer opportunities

As a result, Shriners International has discontinued the distribution of dues stickers in individual Nobles. While the focus remains on scanning the QR code or presenting the digital card to determine the status of dues, to assist in the transition, a limited number of 2023 sticker sheets will be sent to each temple so they can provide a dues sticker to Nobles on a case-by-case or as-requested basis.

When Nobles pay their 2023 membership dues, they will receive a 5x8 acknowledgement postcard that will announce the new process along with instructions on how to obtain their new membership card.

To address three commonly asked questions:

1. How can a Noble access their digital card if we don't have internet access? If internet connectivity is a concern, once the Noble accesses their card via one of the two options above, they can take a screenshot of the digital card, which automatically saves to their photo gallery. Thereafter, they can present the card as needed without needing an internet connection.
2. How can a temple, club, or unit scan a QR code? From an operational standpoint, the barrier to entry to utilize the QR technology is extremely low and simple to use. For the last three years, several Temples have been Scanning the QR code on the existing membership card to determine dues by purchasing a handheld scanner, or a mobile device, like a phone or tablet. Both options connect and communicate with WebFez.
3. Will the digital card display associate temples? Currently only the Noble's home temple will display on the My FezCard Viewer, however, we expect to add a display featuring associate temples by late summer/early fall.

The result of this effort is designed to directly reduce temple expenses, simplify operations, and increase member engagement.





What is Child Care doing? Well, we have been very busy that last couple weeks.

Friday, June 10th, I received a call and e-mail from Imperial Sir Ed Stolz that there was a young child in Ecuador that needed our assistance. There had been a house fire and the child had been seriously injured with burns covering 76% of his body. He needed to be transferred from Ecuador to Boston for treatment. Boston was selected because of the nature of his burns and also due to the expertise of Dr. Sheridan to treat his burns and their location. Working with the Executive Director International Care Strategy for Shriners Children's the transportation was locked in. The cost to move this youngster from Ecuador to Boston was \$57,000 with Aleppo Shriners and Moslem Shriners Child Care programs splitting the cost to have him transferred. After jumping through the many hoops that are necessary to transfer a patient from outside the United States, the youngster and his aunt made the Air Ambulance trip on Sunday, June 12th. I am happy to report that the young man is progressing nicely and that he is also being seen by social workers and Psychologists.

Wednesday, June 29th, I received a call from Laura Kozloski, Executive Director International Care



Strategy for Shriners Children's about a 4-year-old girl that had been severely burned in a house explosion in Mexico. The patient had already been accepted into Galveston Hospital as the family did a self-contact and not going through Tampa.

Once again,
Moslem
Shriners Child
Care stepped

up to the plate and covered $\frac{1}{2}$ of the \$12,000 Air Ambulance cost from Toluca, Mexico to Galveston, Texas. It must be noted that this was second Air Ambulance transfer for the Mexico Temple in a week. The 1,041-mile flight departed Mexico at approximately Noon and arrived in Galveston at 3:30pm on Thursday, June 30.
