From the desk of the Recorder

Visitation By Imperial Potentate and Imperial Officers

It is the desire of your Imperial Potentate to make as many official visitations as are possible. It is also his desire to fully cooperate with all temples requesting visitations. The temple will understand that it is physically impossible to make every official visitation on the requested date, but every effort will be made to accommodate.

The Imperial Potentate wants you to use his official visit for the best interest of your temple and Shrinedom.

In preparing a program for the official visit of the Imperial Potentate, it is requested that a complete résumé of your temples program and what you desire the Imperial Potentate to do be sent to him (copy to the Executive Vice President) as far in advance as possible. He should be informed at what function you want him to speak and the type of audience he will have: that is, whether Shriner only; Shriners and their ladies; Shriners and Masons and their ladies; or to the public. This will acquaint him with your plans and also give him the opportunity to advise you on your program.

The Imperial Potentate is the number one noble of Shriners International and must be accorded the dignity and respect befitting his high office. Protocol dictates that careful plans and arrangements be made prior to his visitation and completed during his visitation.

The host temple potentate, director general, association president or their official representatives should be at the airport to meet the Imperial Potentate upon his arrival. An automobile and driver must be provided who is responsible for transporting the Imperial Potentate, his party, and luggage to the hotel. The driver should remain available at all times.

Honor guard, color guard, or their uniformed units are often used to provide pomp and ceremony for the Imperial Potentate's arrival. Their use is not mandatory; however, motorized shrine units or official police may be used as motorized escorts from the airport to the hotel.

A suite of rooms should be provided for the Imperial Potentate. Normal courtesies are appreciated and should any additional information be required, please contact the Executive Vice President of Shriners International.

When an Imperial officer is assigned by the Imperial Potentate as his official representative, the same protocol is followed as would be in effect for the Imperial Potentate.

All other visiting Imperial officers are afforded the utmost courtesies.

Should your temple have as a member an Imperial officer, the same courtesies should be extended when he is invited to a function as any other visiting Imperial officer.

The Imperial Potentate's host and his assigned aide or driver are responsible for the departure arrangements. These arrangements include transportation of the Imperial Potentate, his party, and luggage to the airport. Sufficient time should be allowed so as to assure the Imperial Potentate's arrival at the airport at least two hours prior to the departure flight time.

ASK A DIVAN MEMBER

Question: We understand there are (2) "corporations" within the Imperial Shrine, can you please explain what they are?

Assistant Rabban Gary Lewandowski answers:

"Good question and one that can be confusing to many. There are in fact (2) Corporations within Imperial Shrine, the "Iowa" Corporation, and the "Colorado" Corporation, named after the State they were originally incorporated in.

The "Iowa" Corporation is the Fraternal side of the Shrine, the "Colorado" Corporation is the Hospital side. These representatives are elected the same night as the Divan elections.

The Iowa Representative can vote on both Fraternal and Hospital related issues, whereas a Colorado Representative can only vote on Hospital related issues, and this voting is done at the Imperial Secessions in July."




You can Help a Shriner Help a Child



Save Your Tabs!

What is the “Pull-Tab Collection Program”?

Pull-tabs, or pop tabs, from beverage cans can be saved and donated to the Moslem Shriners. The tabs are sold to a recycling company and the money collected is used to help Shrine Kids.



Why collect the tabs and not the entire can?

Aluminum has recycling value, and the tab is the only pure aluminum part of the can. The can itself can still be returned for the deposit in Michigan after the tab has been removed.

Where do you deliver the tabs?

Tabs can be dropped off at the Moslem Transportation Bus Garage in Clawson. Call the Garage to make arrangements to drop them off.
