

To the Lancers, great job with finishing up the year strong with parades and putting smiles on children's faces. The cold weather came early but the crowds were large.



Unfortunate loss of experienced tenured staff, due to COVID-19 vaccine requirements.



Through October, Erie patients had some 157 surgeries at our clinical partners, with total cost to the nobility of only \$6430.00. 

